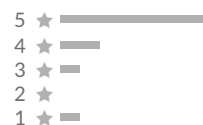

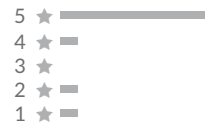
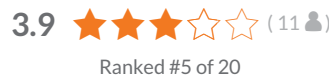


I love class sizes and the smaller school. A sense of community is given. It is important for children to play with siblings, and friends in different classes on the playground.

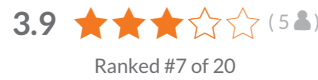
I love the small country town atmosphere and friendly staff. It's a very personable, warm and friendly atmosphere.



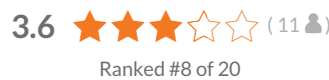

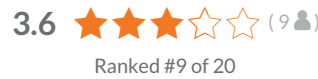
We appreciate the communication and personal/family type relationship within our small school out in Tomahawk.



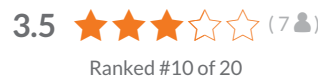
Kids standing up fir themselves Despite the fact that the direction told them that kids don't have a voice.



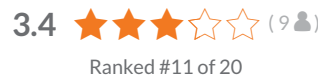
