

Cell Phones and Personal Devices

As many of you likely know, Alberta Education has introduced a new ministerial order limiting the use of cell phones and personal devices (including Smart Watches) in schools. For this reason, we will be requiring all students to keep their phones and personal devices in their lockers during class time. Students in grades 6 -9 will be given a school lock so that they can store their devices safely. If any younger students do choose to bring a device or cell phone, please let their class teacher know so that we can also provide them with a lock. Students will be able to access their phone during all recesses and lunch time as well as before and after school. Please feel free to talk with Miss Gilmour if you have any questions.
