Principal's Message...

As we head into the final four weeks of school, the energy and excitement around Tomahawk School are unmistakable! It has been a whirlwind of learning, exploration, and hands-on experiences for our students—both in and out of the classroom.

Over the past few weeks, our students from Kindergarten to Grade 9 have been out and about on an incredible variety of field trips. Every class has had the opportunity to visit Camp Warwa, engaging in outdoor education activities that build confidence, cooperation, and a connection to nature. Students have also participated in swimming lessons, arts-based in-school workshops, and enriching visits to places like Fort Edmonton Park. A group of students had the chance to watch *Beetlejuice* at Spruce Grove Composite High School, and our Junior High students enjoyed a fun afternoon at the Spring Fling dance hosted by Entwistle School. This week, our Grade 9s are off on a 3-day adventure to Alford Lake, where they'll be fishing, canoeing, completing a 3D archery trail, and learning orienteering skills—an unforgettable way to cap off their time at Tomahawk!

Back on the school grounds, exciting things are happening, too. We've completed the renovation of our chicken coop, and I want to extend a heartfelt thank you to the amazing volunteer families who came out on a Saturday to lend their time and tools to make it happen. We now have 10 student poultry managers helping care for our chicks, with younger students soon joining as helpers. In addition, we've launched a new chapter in our school agriculture program by introducing two beehives to our apiary. Five students have already signed up to become our first school beekeepers! Please note: parental consent is required for students to participate in the beekeeping program.

Looking ahead, we are entering a busy but exciting time. Grade 6 and 9 students will be writing their Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs), and our Junior High students will begin CTF Round 3, which includes options such as foods, film studies, and leather tooling. Other upcoming experiences include birdhouse building, soapstone carving, mini-golf, and an optional Learn to Sail field trip for students in Grade 6 and up.

We'll also be celebrating some important milestones with graduation ceremonies for both our Kindergarten and Grade 9 students. Teachers will be reaching out to families with more information in the coming weeks.

Lastly, as we plan ahead to summer, we'll soon be asking families to consider volunteering a bit of time to help care for our school chicks by refreshing their food and water. Please stay tuned for further details.

Thank you all for your ongoing support and enthusiasm. Let's make these last weeks of school memorable ones for our Timberwolves!

- Make payment at The PSD Centre for Education in Stony Plain.


Parkland County Summer Day Camps
